2.	<p>Can a LMI community solar project primarily funded by this RFP, include 25% of its net revenue to go to a non-profit organization in addition to 75% of its net revenue still going to LMI participants?</p> <p>This situation would be that the community array would be owned by a third party, located at a non-profit organization's facility where 25% of the array's electric generation would be paid to the non-profit from the third party.</p>	<p>A project requesting full funding through this RFP will comply with the basic project eligibility requirements for grant funding if at least 75% of the project's net revenues from electric generation will directly benefit LMI participants. The remaining percentage of such net revenues could be allocated as proposed in the question.</p>
