## **MINUTES**

## **COMMISSION MEETING**

February 20, 2019

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission meeting began at 3:06 p.m. on Wednesday, September 10, 2018. Chairman Martin Honigberg, Commissioner Kathryn Bailey and Commissioner Michael Giaimo were present. The following matters were addressed.

1. Approval of the September 10, 2018 Commission Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey to approve the minutes of the September 10, 2018 Commission Meeting, Commissioner Giaimo seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Rulemaking, Puc 3000, Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules

Commission to Adopt Final Proposal

Chairman Honigberg asked Attorney David Wiesner to briefly describe the status of the Puc 3000 Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules.

Attorney Wiesner stated that the Puc 3000 rules were due to expire, and last year the commission adopted an initial proposal to readopt the rules with amendments. A public hearing was held, public comment was received, as well as comments from the Office of Legislative Services. The final proposal contains revisions based on the comments received, following review by the Commission. Once the final proposal has been adopted, it will then be filed with JLCAR and a hearing will be held by JLCAR probably in March. The amended rules will then be available for adoption in final form by the Commission thereafter.

Commission Giaimo made motion to adopt the final proposal of the Puc 3000 rules. Commissioner Bailey seconded the motion, the motion carried unanimously.
