

MINUTES

COMMISSION MEETING

March 27, 2019

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission meeting began at 9:02 a.m. Chairman Martin Honigberg, Commissioner Kathryn Bailey and Commissioner Michael Giaimo were present. The following matters were addressed.

1. Approval of the February 20, 2019 Commission Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey to approve the minutes of the February 20, 2019, Commissioner Meeting. Chairman Honigberg proposed two minor changes to the minutes. Commissioner Bailey amended the motion to adopt the changes. Commissioner Giaimo seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Rulemaking, Puc 3000, Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules

Chairman Honigberg asked Attorney David Wiesner to briefly describe the status of the Puc 3000 Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules readoption and amendment process.

Attorney Wiesner stated that, on March 15, 2019, JLCAR conditionally approved the final proposal of the Puc 3000 rules with one minor substantive change. Once the Commission approves the conditional approval response, the response will then be submitted to the Office of Legislative Services for its review and approval. The Commission may then adopt the final amended rules and specify their effective date.

Commissioner Giaimo made a motion to adopt the conditional approval response, Commissioner Bailey seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
