## COMMISSION MEETING

# July 10, 2017

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Meeting began at 1:36 P.M. on Monday, July 10, 2017. Chairman Martin Honigberg and Commissioner Kathryn Bailey were present. The following matters were addressed.

#### 1. Approval of the February 7, 2017 Commission Meeting Minutes

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2017 Commission Meeting and Chairman Honigberg seconded the motion, therefore the minutes were adopted.

2. DRM 16-853; Rulemaking, Puc 2000, Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules -Commission Vote to Adopt Final Proposal

Chairman Honigberg stated that the Puc 2000 Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules are ready for adoption of the final proposal.

Chairman Honigberg requested Staff Attorney Wiesner explain briefly the progress of the final proposal of the rules. Attorney Wiesner stated that the final proposal included changes addressing comments received from stakeholders groups, suppliers, two utilities and NH Legal Assistance in January 2017. The Commission had received an extension to file the final proposal with the Office of Legislative Services (OLS) and JLCAR by July 20th. He further stated that, upon approval of the Commission, the final proposal of the rules would be submitted for an amended fiscal impact statement by tomorrow, and then filed with the OLS and JLCAR by next week.

Commissioner Bailey made a motion to adopt the final proposal of the Puc Chapter 2000 Rules, the motion was seconded by Chairman Honigberg, and approved unanimously.
