**ESTIMATE OF DAMAGES
OF GLOBAL CROSSING TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.**

Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. ("Global Crossing") submits this estimate of damages in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to the schedule established during the technical session held on November 5, 2008. *See* Letter from Lynn Frabrizio to Debra Howland, DT 06-067, Nov. 5, 2008.

The spreadsheet attached hereto as Exhibit 1 contains an estimate, with supporting data, of Global Crossing's damages resulting from the improper assessment of carrier common line ("CCL") charges by Verizon from April 2004 through March 2008. The data include month-by-month calculations showing the difference between CCL minutes billed and local switching minutes billed, multiplied by the carrier common line rate of \$.026494 per minute.


The spreadsheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 contains an estimate, with supporting data, of Global Crossing's damages resulting from the improper assessment of CCL charges by FairPoint from April 2008 through June 2008. (From July 2008 onward, improper billing of CCL charges to Global Crossing appears to have ceased.) Like Exhibit 1, the data in Exhibit 2 include month-by-month calculations showing the difference between CCL minutes billed and local switching minutes billed, multiplied by the CCL rate of \$.026494 per minute. Exhibit 2

also shows the amount that FairPoint has credited Global Crossing for the improperly billed CCL charges and the amount that FairPoint continues to owe Global Crossing.

Global Crossing hereby requests that Exhibits 1 and 2 receive confidential treatment pursuant to RSA 378:43. The information contained in those exhibits is not general public knowledge or published elsewhere, is subject to measures that prevent its dissemination in the ordinary course of business, and pertains to the provision of competitive services. Global Crossing is therefore submitting Exhibits 1 and 2 to the Commission on paper to be held in confidence.

Pursuant to the procedures established during the November 5, 2008 technical session, electronic copies of the spreadsheet attached as Exhibit 1 were sent to the Staff and to counsel for Verizon in confidence on November 6, 2008. Electronic copies of the spreadsheet attached as Exhibit 2 were sent to the Staff and counsel for FairPoint in confidence on December 12, 2008.


