During the technical session held on July 14, the Commission staff and parties discussed the procedural schedule for this docket. The Commission staff, Office of Consumer Advocate, Aquarion, Macquarie and Town of Hampton have agreed to the following schedule:

July 31	Last date for data requests to petitioners
August 10	Responses to all pending data requests
August 21	Technical session/settlement conference (at 9 a.m.)
September 8	Testimony from Staff and intervenors
September 20	Hearing

Aquarion and Macquarie agreed to respond to data requests on a rolling basis between now and the July 31 deadline, with responses to be provided ten days after receipt of the requests.
