Staff and Northern Utilities, Inc. have entered into a stipulation and settlement agreement in this docket. The fully executed agreement is attached. Staff and Northern respectfully request a hearing date be set to allow Staff and Northern to present this agreement and testimony to the Commissioners. The settling parties anticipate needing a half-day hearing.

The agreement is the product of lengthy negotiations which included the Staff of the Maine Public Utilities Commission.
