PETITION FOR INTERVENTION

Rules Puc 203.17, and respectfully requests that it be allowed to intervene in the above-numbered PUC Docket and all related proceedings.

As grounds, it is stated that:

1. The Campaign for Ratepayers Rights (CRR) is a statewide citizens' organization concerned about utilities regulation, electric rates and their impact on ratepayers in the State of New Hampshire. For twenty-five years, CRR has defended the interests of state energy consumers.
2. CRR has before participated in PUC ratemaking, financial, competition, and other dockets. Its standing has been upheld on several occasions.
3. The rights, interests and privileges of CRR and its members may be affected by the outcome of the above-referenced proceeding.
4. CRR is represented by counsel, Robert A. Backus, Esq. and by its Executive Director, Patrick J. Arnold.
