Amendment to Special Contract with City of Manchester for Centrex Service

Dear Mr. Nestor:

On January 16, 2008, Verizon New Hampshire (Verizon) filed an amendment to extend an existing special contract with the City of Manchester, for Centrex analog and Centrex ISDN-BRI service, for a period of 36 months. In support of the filing, Verizon submitted records and information, including contract terms and conditions, for which it requested confidential treatment pursuant to RSA 378:43.

Staff has reviewed the documentation filed in support of the special contract and recommended that it be allowed to go into effect. According to Staff, the contract rate meets the price floor requirements of RSA 378:18-b, II.

For administrative efficiency, the Commission will not issue an order suspending, rejecting, or approving the proposed special contract. Accordingly, pursuant to RSA 378:18-b, II(a), the proposed contract between Verizon and the City of Manchester is effective as of February 15, 2008.
