Dear Ms. Howland:

I have enclosed seven copies of Granite State Electric Company's d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company") proposed Default Service rates for the period May 1, 2008 through July 31, 2008 for the Large Customer Group and for the period May 1, 2008 through October 31, 2008 for the Small Customer Group. This letter summarizes our filing. This filing includes the testimony of John D. Warshaw, and accompanying schedules. Confidential sections of certain schedules to Mr. Warshaw's testimony have been omitted from the public version of this filing and have been provided to the Commission under separate cover, together with a motion for confidential treatment. Seven copies of the confidential materials have also been provided.

This filing also includes the testimony and accompanying schedules of Scott M. McCabe regarding the proposed Default Service rates, including rate adjustments made in accordance with the Default Service Adjustment Provision and the Default Service Cost Reclassification Adjustment Provision of the Company's tariff. Confidential sections of certain schedules to Mr. McCabe's testimony have been omitted from the public version of this filing and have been provided to the Commission under separate cover, together with a motion for confidential treatment. Mr. McCabe's testimony also addresses the reconciliation of Default Service power supply expense and the reconciliation of the administrative costs of providing Default Service. 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National Grid undertook a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to provide Default Service in accordance with RSA 374-F:3, V(c) and pursuant to the Commission's Order No. 24,577 issued on January 13, 2006 in Docket No. DE 05-126. National Grid circulated the RFP to approximately twenty-five potential wholesale suppliers, every member of the NEPOOL Markets Committee and posted the RFP on the Company's energy supply website. National Grid employed a procurement process consistent with those previously approved by the Commission on several occasions.¹

National Grid believes the proposed Default Service rates are consistent with RSA 374-F:3, V(c), Commission precedent, and are in the public interest as reflective of "competitive market" prices. See RSA 374-F:3, V(c). Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the proposed rates to become effective for usage on and after May 1, 2008, no later than March 24, 2008.
