I understand that there is another hearing on the proposed 311% rate hike for Locke Lake Colony residents on Wednesday, October 7th. I am writing to share my disgust that the PUC believes Pennichuck has the right to charge back consumers for something we never approved. Even if the agreed upon increase is 100%, there is no way Barnstead residents can pay \$80 per month for water, especially given the current economy.

It was published that Pennichuck could not obtain a revolving loan from PUC because it would have taken 15 months to approve...and the system was in dire need and could not wait. So because the PUC takes 15 months to approve a loan, me and my neighbors must suffer.
