Registration Renewal as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Mr. Habib:

On May 29, 2008, you filed on behalf of Consumer Energy Solutions, Inc. (Consumer Energy) with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) applications for registration renewals as natural gas and electric aggregators, together with a check in the amount of \$500.00 to cover the cost of both the natural gas and electric renewal registrations. This letter addresses the natural gas registration renewal and the \$500.00 check submitted with the applications.

The Commission has reviewed Consumer Energy's completed application for its renewal registration as a natural gas aggregator. Its application meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve Consumer Energy Solutions, Inc. renewal as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective June 28, 2008, coinciding with the expiration of the current registration. This registration will expire at the end of business on June 27, 2010.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Consumer Energy, on or before April 27, 2010. Pursuant to Puc 3003.02 (d), each natural gas aggregator shall notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission.

Further, please be advised that currently there is no provision in the N.H. Code Admin Rules that requires payment of a fee for renewal of a registration as a natural gas or electric aggregator. Accordingly, your check in the amount of \$500.00 is returned to Keegan Werlin, LLP with this approval letter.
