No. PSNH and Lempster entered into discussions for PSNH to buy the power and RECs from the Project in 2004, long before the NH RPS requirements became law. If PSNH needs NH RECs and power in the future, PSNH will evaluate the market and determine how to produce the best arrangement for its customers. No such documentation exists.
