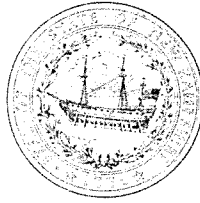

Dear Mr. Orr:

On July 25, 2008, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a notice of intent to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation services in New Hampshire from US Energy Management Services (USEMS). Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following item which must be addressed before USEMS' application can be approved:

- 1) Puc 2003.02 (c) requires "an electronic copy on diskette" to be filed with the notification. Please supply a diskette.

Please address this requirement within 30 days so that Staff may proceed with your request to register as an aggregator of electric services. Failure to respond in a timely manner may result in the Commission dismissing, without prejudice, USEMS' application. Also, please be advised that you should reference the docket number, DM 08-093, in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
