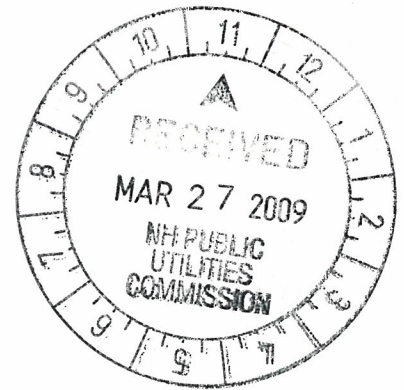

Subject: DG 08-117: Cost of Gas Adjustment Monthly Reconciliation, March 2009

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 24,910, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected –over/under collection for the 2008-09 winter period.

The computations are based on estimated costs and revenues through March and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations indicate a projected under-collection through April 30, 2009 of \$56,523 and would necessitate a \$0.4510 increase to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.6498, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$2.1008 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the forecasted increased rate of \$2.1008 per therm for the April 1st billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 24,910 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued October 31, 2008.


