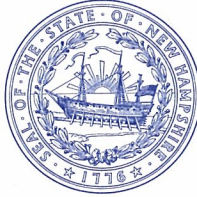

Dear Ms. Howland:

On February 27, 2009, segTEL, Inc., (segTEL), Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) and Staff attended a technical session at which they tentatively agreed upon a partial proposed procedural schedule.

Participants agreed to the following proposed procedural schedule:

Deadline for segTEL to prepare draft proposed public notice document(s)	March 6, 2009
Deadline for segTEL to prepare draft proposed stipulation of facts	March 16, 2009
Technical session	March 18, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.
Deadline for filing final stipulation of facts	March 27, 2009

Participants agreed that it's possible that resolution of this docket may be accomplished based upon written briefs, without an adjudicatory hearing, however, they wish to attempt to come to a stipulation of facts before committing to that. Parties and Staff further agreed that an expeditious determination by the Commission as to the following notice related issues:

1. Whether public notice shall be required in this docket;
2. If public notice is required, what form and content of notice will be required; and

3. Whether, in addition to public notice, a public comment hearing is required.

Parties and Staff agreed that public notice, if required, should be implemented by the Commission.
