Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Indeck Energy-Alexandria, LLC (“Indeck”) to be reinstated for New Hampshire Class I renewable portfolio certification.

During the early part of the 3Q 2010, Indeck-Alexandria experienced operational issues that made complying with the nitrogen dioxide (NOx) emissions standard very expensive, if not impossible to meet. Indeck would have had to lower its facility capacity as well as increase its variable generating costs during a period of deflated REC market pricing to achieve the NH Class I compliance goal for 3Q 2010. During its fall planned outage in the latter part of 3Q 2010, maintenance was performed on the unit to alleviate the problem and the current NOx emissions for 4Q 2010 are and will be in compliance with the requirements of RSA 362-F:12.

Indeck-Alexandria requests that its eligibility in the New Hampshire Class I RPS not be suspended for 4Q 2010. A copy of the emissions data for October and November of 2010 is attached to demonstrate that the unit is capable of complying with the standard.
