Dear Mr. Coolbroth:

On January 29, 2009, Granite State Telephone, Inc. and Omnipoint Communications, Inc., d/b/a T-Mobile (Omnipoint) jointly filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a negotiated Traffic Exchange Agreement (Agreement). The petition was filed for approval pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). The Agreement sets forth terms and conditions that will facilitate the provision of telecommunications service by Omnipoint in New Hampshire.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC §252(e)(4), the Traffic Exchange Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.
