

Dear Mr. Paquette:

On February 18, 2009, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a notice of intent to provide electric aggregation services in New Hampshire from Enbrook LLC (Enbrook). Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following item which must be addressed before Enbrook can be registered as an aggregator:

Puc 2003.02 (c) (4) requires a "toll free telephone number of the customer service contact person". The telephone number you submitted, which is used for administration and customer support, does not meet this requirement. Please provide the Commission with a toll free number which can be used by customers.

Please address this discrepancy as soon as possible so that Staff may proceed with your request to register as an aggregator of electric services. Failure to respond in a timely manner may result in the Commission dismissing, without prejudice, Enbrook's application. Also, please be advised that you should reference the docket number, DM 09-027, in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
