On June 3, 2009, I held a conference call with the parties in my role as arbitrator (the "Arbitrator") to discuss the status of ongoing negotiations and the procedural schedule in the above-referenced matter. The call was prompted, in part, by the Commission's recent resolution of various pending matters and to provide me with an update on the parties' continuing efforts to resolve their dispute voluntarily or, barring complete resolution, to narrow the issues for arbitration.

Subsequent to the call, the parties notified me that they were unable to agree on terms that, subject to Commission approval, would extend their negotiation period. However, according to the approved procedural schedule, the parties were required to provide the Arbitrator with a joint submission of contested issues by June 5, 2009.
