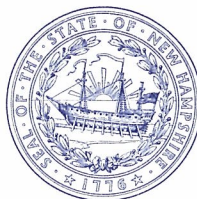

Dear Ms. Howland:

On September 24, 2009, Staff filed a letter with the Commission in the above-captioned docket indicating that we would be filing a procedural schedule for the Time of Use Pilot Program, one of four projects in Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES) filing for approval of distributed energy generation projects. The letter indicated that the parties and Staff agreed to move on the Time of USE Pilot Program on a faster track than the remaining three projects.

Here is the proposed procedural schedule for the Time of Use Pilot Project:
