Dear Mr. Muro:

On September 2, 2009, Energy New England, LLC d/b/a ENE Energy New England (ENE Energy New England) filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with a check in the amount of \$250.00. On September 15, 2009 ENE Energy New England filed supplemental information required pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rules Puc 3002.02

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve ENE Energy New England as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective September 16, 2009. This registration will expire at the end of business on September 15, 2011.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of ENE Energy New England, on or before July 18, 2011. Pursuant to Puc 3003.02 (d), each natural gas aggregator shall notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. There is currently no provision in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 which requires a fee for the renewal of the registration as a natural gas aggregator.
