Interventions and Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On October 19, 2009, a duly noticed prehearing conference was held in the above referenced proceeding. Appearances at the prehearing conference were entered by representatives of Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), TransCanada Power Marketing, Ltd. (TransCanada), Freedom Logistics, LLC (Freedom), Halifax-American Energy Company, LLC (Halifax), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (participating as a full statutory party), and Commission Staff. On October 19, 2009, the New England Power Generators Association, Inc. (NEPGA) petitioned for intervention.

On October 27, 2009, Staff filed a letter addressing the intervention motions of TransCanada, Freedom and Halifax. Staff represents in its letter that PSNH assented to the motions provided that the interveners not be allowed access to PSNH's confidential information. No objections to the NEPGA motion have been received.

There being no objections and recognizing that each of the parties has demonstrated, as required by RSA 541-A:32, "rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other substantial interests" that may be affected by this proceeding, the Commission has determined to grant the motions to intervene of TransCanada, Freedom, Halifax and NEPGA subject to limitations on access to confidential information

Following the October 19th prehearing conference, the parties and Staff met in a technical session and agreed upon the following schedule which was submitted to the Commission by letter from Staff dated October 20, 2009:
