To the Parties:

On November 24, 2009, New England Power Company (NEP) filed its report on the reconciliation of Contract Termination Charges (CTC) to Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) for the period October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009. The current charge in the CTC is recovered from National Grid's retail customers through National Grid's stranded cost charge that was found to be just and reasonable subject to any potential adjustments arising in the review conducted in the instant proceeding. *See* Commission Order No. 25,057 (December 29, 2009). On February 3, 2010, Staff filed a recommendation to close the docket noting that no adjustments to the CTC are required.

Inasmuch as no further action on the part of the Commission is required at this time, Docket No. DE 09-238 has been closed.
