Dear Customers:

The 2010 rate case (Docket No.: 2010-8) of the Fryeburg Water Company (FWC) was resolved through a Stipulation with the Public Advocate and approved by the Maine Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on April 16, 2010.

The Stipulation represents an increase of \$62,257 over the 2009 revenues, or a 12.9% increase over the Company's actual 2009 operating revenues for service on or after April 1, 2010.

The rate case is now before the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission for review and we hope to have approval by the next billing cycle for our East Conway customers.

Enclosed are Fryeburg Water Company's Revised Schedule of Rates as well as your July 2010 invoice for water service, which reflects the rate increase retroactive to April 1, 2010.

Dear New Hampshire Customers:

The Fryeburg Water Company hereby notifies its New Hampshire customers that a proposed increase in rates has been filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.

The Company has experienced losses in each of the past three years and without rate relief will be unable to meet its obligations.

We have filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission a rate increase application, and associated schedules and exhibits. This filing together with the Maine filing, which was granted by the Maine Public Utilities Commission on April 16, 2010, is being made to increase annual revenue for the Fryeburg Water Company by approximately 12.9% in general rates representing a \$62.257 increase over 2009 test year revenues. This increase is driven primarily by a significant decline in bulk water sales, to levels well below those used in the 2006 test year for our most recent case.

The Fryeburg Water Company requests that the increase become effective October 1, 2010. In the meantime, you will continue to be billed at the 2009 rates until approval and confirmation is received from the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.
