Dear Ms. Howland:

I enclose and original and six copies of Granite State Electric Company's d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company") proposed Default Service rates for the period August 1, 2010 through October 31, 2010 for the Large and Medium Commercial and Industrial Customer Group (the "Large Customer Group"). This filing includes the testimony of Margaret M. Janzen, and accompanying schedules as well as a redacted version of the Company's summary of bids for compliance with the New Hampshire RPS law (RSA 362-F). Confidential sections of certain schedules to Ms. Janzen's testimony have been omitted from the public version of this filing and have been provided to the Commission under separate cover along with the confidential version of the RPS bid summary, together with a motion for confidential treatment.

In accordance with RSA 374-F:3 V(c), and pursuant to Commission Order 24,577 issued on January 13, 2006 in Docket No. DE 05-126, the Company and its retail distribution affiliates in Massachusetts, Massachusetts Electric Company and Nantucket Electric Company, issued a joint request for proposals ("RFP") to supply the Company's Default Service. National Grid circulated the RFP to over twenty-five potential wholesale suppliers, every member of the NEPOOL Markets Committee and posted the RFP on the Company's energy supply website.

This procurement process was consistent with those previously approved by the Commission on several occasions.<sup>1</sup>

National Grid believes the proposed Default Service rates are consistent with RSA 374-F:3, V(c), Commission precedent, and are in the public interest as reflective of "competitive market" prices. See RSA 374-F:3, V(c). Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission approve the proposed rates to become effective for service on and after August 1, 2010 no later than June 21, 2010.
