Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,098, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected –over/under collection for the 2010 summer period.

The computations are based on estimated costs and revenues through May and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations indicate a projected over-collection through October 31, 2010 of (\$15,911) and would necessitate a (\$0.0766) decrease to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.6796, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$1.6030 per therm.

At this time the Company does not elect to implement the forecasted decrease for the June 1st billing cycle.
