On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, I enclose for filing seven copies of N.H.P.U.C. No. 3, Tariff Pages 110 through 114 which contain the Company's on-bill financing provision associated with its RE-CORE Programs. These programs have been approved by the Governor and Executive Council and thus these tariff pages are being submitted in accordance with that approval. The Company has included a May 15th effective date on the tariff but is seeking approval of the tariff as soon as possible so that it may begin to obligate the loan funds. The Company is also submitting to the Commission on an informational basis a copy of its customer loan agreement for the on-bill financing program. It should be noted; payments received by Unitil are credited to the utility service amount due for that month prior to being credited to the Loan amount due. Utility service amounts due receive priority.
