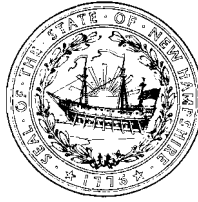

To the Parties:

On October 5, 2010, the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a motion to limit the scope of the instant proceeding to exclude consideration of Pennichuck Water Works, Inc.'s (PWW) eminent domain defense costs. PWW objected to the motion on October 14, 2010. The Commission has determined that the motion is premature, at present. To the extent circumstances change after legal briefs are filed in Docket No. DW 04-048, the eminent domain proceeding, the Commission will reconsider the OCA request.

Further, due to internal scheduling conflicts, the permanent rate hearing has been rescheduled to May 3rd and 4th, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.
