Dear Mr. Shea:

On April 21, 2010, CRC Communications of Maine, Inc. d/b/a Pine Tree Networks (Pine Tree) and Northland Telephone Company of Maine, Inc. d/b/a FairPoint Communications – Northland Telephone Co. of Maine, jointly filed an Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission. The petition was filed for approval pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). The Agreement sets forth terms and conditions that will facilitate the provision of telecommunications service by Pine Tree in New Hampshire.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC §252(e)(4), the Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.
