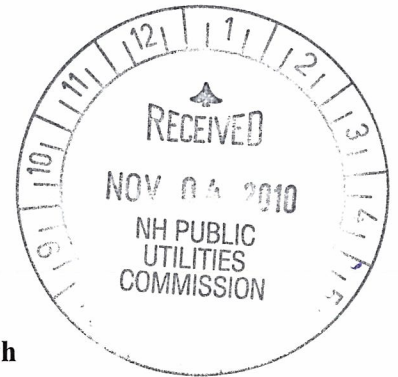

Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Clean Power Development, LLC with regard to Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC's Notice of Withdrawal filed on October 28, 2010 in this proceeding.

Clean Power Development regrets that it was necessary for Laidlaw to withdraw from this proceeding. CPD, however, agrees that the focus of the proceeding should remain on the Power Purchase Agreement and that, as the Commission found, Laidlaw's confidential documents really should not have a bearing on that inquiry. As CPD noted previously at the Prehearing Conference held on September 29, 2010, it saw no need here to conduct any discovery on Laidlaw.

CPD wishes to see this matter reach an rapid conclusion and supports all efforts to keep the schedule intact.
