Expedited Request for Permission to Excuse Witness from Hearing

Dear Ms. Howland:

Yesterday, the City of Nashua, New Hampshire filed a settlement agreement on behalf of itself, Pennichuck Corporation, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc., Pennichuck East Utility, Inc., Pittsfield Aqueduct Company, Inc., the Staff of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission, the Town of Milford, New Hampshire, the Merrimack Valley Regional Water District, Anheuser-Busch Incorporated and Fred Teeboom (the "Settling Parties"). The Settling Parties will present this settlement agreement at the hearing scheduled on October 25, 2011.
