DUAL FUEL EQUIPMENT RIDER

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Rider is to enable a customer with dual fuel equipment under an applicable firm rate schedule to maintain access to capacity on the Company's distribution system, while displacing natural gas delivery service provided by the Company with the Customer's alternate fuel at the Customer's discretion. The terms of this Rider enable the Company to recover a minimum annual revenue requirement from such Customer during the period of reduced utilization of the Company's firm service, thereby protecting the Company's other customers against the shifting of such costs that might otherwise occur.

2.0 APPLICABILITY

This Rider shall be applicable to any Customer that is (1) taking firm delivery service under any of the Company's Commercial & Industrial Rate Schedules, (2) that has installed equipment capable of burning natural gas and one or more fuels not delivered by the Company for the same purpose, and (3) that meets the Company's criteria relative to Customer size, impact of Customer demand, and location of Customer on the Company's system as set forth in the Company's Policy on Dual Fuel Utilization.


3.0 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT

Customer is responsible for notifying the Company of any dual fuel equipment at Customer's location upon initial application for service under an applicable rate schedule. Any Customer that installs or has previously installed dual fuel equipment at any time while taking service from the Company under an applicable rate schedule shall notify the Company of the installation.

4.0 TERM

The minimum term shall be one year from the initial operation of dual fuel equipment by the Customer. The initial term shall be automatically extended for successive one year terms, unless terminated by written notice to the Company at least 30 days prior to the termination of the currently effective term. Should Customer cease taking service from the Company prior to the end of the term of this Rider, the terms of this Rider shall continue in effect until terminated in accordance with the terms herein.

DUAL FUEL EQUIPMENT RIDER

5.0 MINIMUM ANNUAL REVENUE REQUIREMENT

Customer shall be responsible for payment to Company of a minimum annual revenue requirement (“MAAR”), net of any charges by the Company via its Cost of Gas Factor, Environmental Response Cost Rate Adjustment, Energy Efficiency Rate Assessment, Residential Low Income Program Recovery Rate.

Customer’s MAAR shall be calculated by multiplying the appropriate charge listed below times the Customer’s maximum daily quantity (“MDQ”).

- Constrained Capacity¹: \$11.46 per therm
- Unconstrained Capacity²: \$0.69 per therm

The difference between the Customer’s MARR and its actual annual revenue net of the charges stated above shall be due to Company at the anniversary date of the Company providing service to Customer under this Rider. For any year that the difference between the minimum annual revenue requirement and Customer’s actual annual revenue is zero or negative, no additional charge shall apply

Annual Inflation Adjustment to Annual Unit Long Run Marginal Cost (“LRMC”):

The Company shall adjust the annual unit LRMC by using the gross domestic product price index (“GDP-PI”) annual inflation adjustment each November 1.

Determination of Customer’s MDQ:

Either:

- a. Rated hourly natural gas input of all dual fuel equipment times 24 hours, or
- b. The peak day use of the Customer’s dual fuel equipment, agreed upon between the Company and Customer, using recent historical energy consumption data; or alternatively, the Company using the daily base load, plus the Customer’s use per effective degree day (“EDD”) times design day EDDs; these estimating factors shall be based on Customer’s annual total energy requirements; or
- c. If Customer has both dual fuel equipment and dedicated gas-fired equipment the Customer’s MDQ shall be either (a) or (b) above, plus a representative MDQ of the dedicated gas-fired equipment using either historical Customer data or an agreed upon MDQ between the Company and Customer.


¹ Full Charge - Annual per unit (“LRMC”) from the Company’s most recent rate proceeding adjusted each year, effective September 1, for inflation, by the Customer’s MDQ.

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Rider is to enable a customer with dual fuel equipment under an applicable firm rate schedule to maintain access to capacity on the Company's distribution system, while displacing natural gas delivery service provided by the Company with the Customer's alternate fuel at the Customer's discretion. The terms of this Rider enable the Company to recover a minimum annual revenue requirement from such Customer during the period of reduced utilization of the Company's firm service, thereby protecting the Company's other customers against the shifting of such costs that might otherwise occur.

2.0 APPLICABILITY

This Rider shall be applicable to any Customer that is (1) taking firm delivery service under any of the Company's Commercial & Industrial Rate Schedules, (2) that has installed equipment capable of burning natural gas and one or more fuels not delivered by the Company for the same purpose, and (3) that meets the Company's criteria relative to Customer size, impact of Customer demand, and location of Customer on the Company's system as set forth in the Company's Policy on Dual Fuel Utilization.

3.0 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT



Annual Inflation Adjustment to Annual Unit Long Run Marginal Cost (“LRMC”):

The Company shall adjust the annual unit LRMC by using the gross domestic product price index (“GDP-PI”) annual inflation adjustment each November 1.

Determination of Customer’s MDQ:

Either:

- a. Rated hourly natural gas input of all dual fuel equipment times 24 hours, or
- b. The peak day use of the Customer’s dual fuel equipment, agreed upon between the Company and Customer, using recent historical energy consumption data; or alternatively, the Company using the daily base load, plus the Customer’s use per effective degree day (“EDD”) times design day EDDs; these estimating factors shall be based on Customer’s annual total energy requirements; or
- c. If Customer has both dual fuel equipment and dedicated gas-fired equipment the Customer’s MDQ shall be either (a) or (b) above, plus a representative MDQ of the dedicated gas-fired equipment using either historical Customer data or an agreed upon MDQ between the Company and Customer.




