Enclosed please find seven copies of Public Service Company of New Hampshire's ("PSNH") response to Staff Data Request Set No. 01, Request 15 in the above-captioned matter. Request 015 seeks the megawatt-hours and prices for purchases from Pinetree Power, Inc. (Bethlehem), Pinetree Power-Tamworth, Inc. (Tamworth) and Lempster Wind, LLC (Lempster). When the contracts were approved for Bethlehem and Tamworth, confidentiality was coterminous with the contracts. Docket No. DE 07-125, Order No. 24,839, slip op. at 10 (April 4, 2008). The contracts ended on December 31, 2010. The Lempster contract prices were protected under an approved Motion for Protective Order which will be in effect for five years until 2014. Docket No. DE 08-077, Order No. 24,965, slip op. at 2 (May 1, 2009).

PSNH has enclosed seven redacted copies with the Lempster prices redacted for the Commission's public file and seven unredacted copies which should be subject to the continuing confidential treatment for the Lempster prices afforded by Order No. 24,965.
