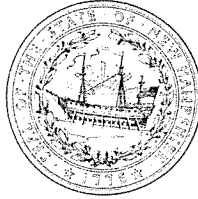


On May 6, 2011, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Conservation Services Group on behalf of Princeton Crossing L. P. (Princeton Crossing) requesting certification for the Princeton Commons photovoltaic facility as a Class II renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff reviewed your application and requested additional information on May 19, 2010; your response of June 15 is greatly appreciated. Upon further review, the Commission has additional questions that need to be addressed:

- 1.) It appears that each of these arrays has an individual meter; why do they have separate meters yet one GIS identification number?
- 2.) Will the 1 Technology Drive, Chelmsford, MA facility be reported to the GIS as a single production number or is reporting done facility-by-facility to achieve total production?
- 3.) Docket No. 10-156 was for Princeton Properties Solar Aggregation (Princeton Aggregation.) The current docket (DE 11-099) is for Princeton Crossing (Princeton Commons). The Commission would like some clarification about

what facilities are represented by the separate names and the overall relationship of the named entities.

These items must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it cannot be processed. If the requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days, your file will be closed without prejudice.
