Dear Mr. Fromuth,

On May 24, 2011, you filed on behalf of Freedom Energy Logistics, LLC (Freedom) a request for waiver of the 60 day notice of renewal set out in New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05 (a). Freedom's registration as an aggregator expired on February 18, 2011. According to your request, the expiration of Freedom's registration was due to an "internal administrative error." In your application, you note that Freedom has not been involved with any commercial electricity aggregation since the expiration nor have any residential customers been quoted from a supplier by Resident Power, a division of Freedom's. Finally, a notice of renewal for Freedom was filed on May 13, 2011.

Pursuant to Puc 201.05(a), the Commission has determined that granting a waiver is in the public interest and will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission has granted the request for a one time waiver of the renewal notice requirement contained in Puc 2003.05 (a).
