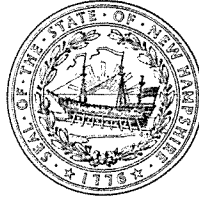

2013 Alternative Compliance Payment Obligation

Dear Mr. Robbins:

South Jersey Energy Company, d/b/a Halifax American Energy Company (South Jersey) filed a Form E-2500 Annual Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) Compliance Filing with respect to the 2013 compliance year on July 15, 2014, thirteen days past the required filing deadline of July 1, 2014 pursuant to Puc 2503.03(a) and RSA 362-F:8. This report indicates that the sum of \$32,910 in alternative compliance payments (ACP) is due from South Jersey for the 2013 compliance year. Pursuant to Puc 2503.03(c) and RSA 362-F:10, II, this amount was required to be paid to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission at the same time as the filing of the Annual RPS Compliance Report, on or before July 1, 2014 either with a check made payable to the State of New Hampshire or through electronic transfer to the renewable energy fund bank account. To date, however, the required ACP has not been received from South Jersey.

Please pay this amount in full within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. If full payment is not received by such date, then the South Jersey ACP account balance may be subject to further collection action, including eventual referral for collection to the New Hampshire Department of Justice pursuant to RSA 7:15-a. In addition, the Commission may initiate an adjudicative proceeding to impose penalty sanctions of up to \$1,000 per day for each violation of an applicable state statute, pursuant to Puc 2005.01(b).
