Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed please find an original and six copies of a Petition for Approval of New Transmission Cost Adjustment Mechanism (TCAM) Rate. PSNH does not currently have a calculation of what the proposed rate will be; however, the overall average charge will not be the same as the current overall average rate of 1.501 cents per kilowatt-hour.

On June 13, 2011, PSNH plans to file the testimony and attachments of Robert A. Baumann containing a calculation of the average rate to be applied on and after July 1, 2011. PSNH also plans to file the testimony and exhibits of Stephen R. Hall describing the calculation of the actual TCAM charges for each class.

PSNH requests that the Commission open a proceeding and schedule a hearing so that a final determination of a rate may be made in order to have the TCAM rate change on July 1, 2011 when PSNH also plans to change other rate components. The Commission has already scheduled hearings on June 23, 2011 when the Energy Service and Stranded Cost Recovery Charge hearings will also be held. PSNH believes the TCAM rate proceeding to have very little controversy, and the Commission could hear PSNH's request for a TCAM rate change on that same date.

Copies of this filing have been provided to the Staff of the Commission and the Office of Consumer Advocate pursuant to NH Code Admin. Rule Puc §203.02 and Puc §203.11.
