Dear Ms. Howland:

On behalf of Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid and in accordance with Order No. 25,101, I enclose for filing seven (7) copies of the Company's proposed GreenUp Service Recovery Adjustment Factor for the estimated administrative costs of the GreenUp program in its second year (July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012). The Company is estimating the GreenUp Service Recovery Adjustment Factor will be \$0.00000, effective July 1, 2011. Pursuant to the Company's GreenUp Service Recovery Provision, Original Page 129 of the Company's tariff, the Company will continue to reconcile GreenUp administrative costs against revenue billed through the factor<sup>1</sup>, with any under or over collection reflected in a future GreenUp Service Recovery Adjustment Factor. Costs associated with the first year of the GreenUp program will be reconciled as part of the Company's annual retail reconciliation filing.

Also enclosed are illustrative bill impacts reflecting the impact of the change on the monthly bills of customers receiving default service. Please note that the Company will be providing a revised tariff page 84 to reflect all rate changes that are effective as of July 1, 2011, including the proposed change in the GreenUp Service Recovery Adjustment Factor.

<sup>1</sup> Under the Company's proposal, there would be no revenue billed to customers during the twelve-month period July 2011 through June 2012 as the estimate of administrative costs allowed to be recovered through the factor are too small to calculate a factor.
