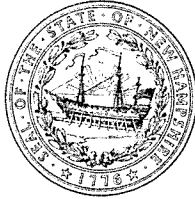

Inquiry on Affiliate Status

Dear Mr. Fallquist:

On January 31, 2012, the Commission approved the application of Viridian Energy MD LLC (Viridian) for registration as a competitive energy supplier pursuant to New Hampshire Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000. The application included a document identified as Exhibit 2 which depicts Viridian's parent company, Regional Energy Holdings, Inc., and Viridian's affiliates. As described in the application, none of Viridian's affiliates conduct business in the State of New Hampshire.

Recently, a third party has contacted the Commission alleging that Viridian is an affiliate of Glacial Energy of New England, Inc. (Glacial). Glacial is registered as a competitive energy supplier in New Hampshire, and if Viridian and Glacial are affiliates, both would be required to make that disclosure on the application for registration as a competitive energy supplier.

The purpose of this letter is to seek information from Viridian regarding the claim that Viridian and Glacial are affiliates. Your response to this letter should be in writing and should reference the docket number DM 11-175. I appreciate your anticipated cooperation with this inquiry.
