On November 28, 2011, the Commission issued Order No. 25,293 in the above-named docket setting the date and time for a hearing and technical session. By this letter, segTEL, Inc., requests to intervene in DT 11-248 pursuant to the Commission's Order and the NH Code of Administrative Rules, Puc 203.17.

segTEL is a competitive local exchange provider in New Hampshire, and in that role both owns utility poles in the state as well as attaching to poles owned by Northern New England Telephone Operations, LLC, pursuant to a variety of pole attachment agreements and the NH Code of Administrative Rules, Puc Chapter 1300. segTEL's ability to serve its customers is directly affected by its ability to obtain pole attachments at rates, terms and conditions that are just and reasonable, and how the Commission ensures that FairPoint continues to provide those services in a nondiscriminatory and competitively neutral manner.

For the foregoing reasons, segTEL requests intervention in this proceeding.
