On November 18, 2011, Public Service Company of New Hampshire filed a Motion for Establishment of Temporary Rates in the docket to be established for the consideration of the costs of the Company's Scrubber Project. On page 5 of that motion, the Company cited to *Appeal of the Office of the Consumer Advocate*, 134 N.H. 651 (1991). The purpose of this letter is to clarify that the citation to *Appeal of the Office of the Consumer Advocate* was misplaced in the paragraph and should have followed the first sentence of paragraph 12, which reads "RSA 378:27, the "Temporary Rates" statute, provides the Commission with broad discretion and authority to "fix, determine, and prescribe" temporary rates.
