Dear Public Utilities Commission,

Based on the Senate Bill 324 that was signed into law on June 16, 2014 revising the Public Utilities Commission Assessment statute, RSA 363-A Atlantic Group Energy, Inc. would like to request withdrawal of its registration under docket <u>DM 13-359</u> and <u>DM 11-252</u> and DM-11-251 and DM 10-002 as a provider of electric load/natural gas aggregation service with the Public Utilities Commission of New Hampshire, effective as of June 30, 2014. Atlantic Group Energy, Inc. is a broker of retail energy and not an aggregator. Due to the lack of a definition of our services in the statute we feel that the assessment of \$2000 annually is excessive.

If for some reason the statute is revised to address the difference between an aggregator and a broker we would like the ability to have our license re-instated without prejudice.

We currently have no retail customers, and we have not served any retail customers during the past 90 days.
