Dear Mr. Cetola:

On December 20, 2011, Hess Corporation (Hess) filed with the Commission an application for renewal of its registration as a competitive natural gas supplier (CNGS), together with the renewal application fee of \$250.00.

Following its review of the filing, Commission Staff has determined that the renewal application for registration as a CNGS meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. On January 31, 2012, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the application. The Commission will approve the registration with an effective date of February 19, 2012, which coincides with the expiration of the existing registration for Hess. The renewal registration will expire at the end of business on February 17, 2017.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02(a), each CNGS shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Hess, on or before December 17, 2016. Please file a timely renewal application.
