Enclosed for filing please find one original and two (2) copies of revised pages to NIIPUC Tariff No. 3 of Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE ("FairPoint Communications"). This filing makes revisions to incorporate the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission Report and Order in WC Docket No. 10-90, et. al., FCC No. 11-161 (released Nov 18, 2011) ("FCC Order") regarding the treatment of Toll VoIP-PSTN traffic.
