DG 12-071: Cost of Gas Adjustment Monthly Reconciliation, June 2012

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,353, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected (over)/under collection for the 2012 summer period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues for May and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations show a projected over-collection through October 31, 2012 of \$13,280 and would necessitate a \$0.0742 decrease to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.2767, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$1.2025 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the revised rate of \$1.2025 per therm for the July 1<sup>st</sup> billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 25,353 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued April 30, 2012.
