RE: DT 07-027 Patnode Data Requests Set One; Agreement to extend time to file a motion to compel

Dear Ms. Howland:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Commission of an agreement between TDS and New Hampshire Legal Assistance ("NHLA") to extend time to file a motion to compel. Here is the agreement and its surrounding facts:

1. On August 14, 2007, NHLA propounded Patnode Data Requests Set One to TDS. On August 24, 2007, TDS filed objections to some of NHLA's data requests. The deadline for filing a motion to compel the answers to these questions is today.

2. TDS and NHLA have made significant progress in addressing TDS's objections and NHLA's requests for information and/or clarification. TDS and NHLA are continuing to work together to resolve these issues, within the spirit of Puc 203.09(h)(4). In that light, TDS has agreed to extend the time for NHLA to file a motion to compel TDS's responses to Set One requests until Wednesday, September 19, 2007, in the hope of resolving the outstanding issues.

3. To the extent a formal request for an extension of time is needed, we request that this letter be deemed such a request, and the request be granted. All parties have been notified today of this agreement between TDS and NHLA. We have requested responses from any party that has an objection to this agreement. We have yet to receive an objection.

We thank you for your attention to this matter.
