The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) requests that the Commission conduct public statement hearings in the service territory of the four TDS companies in the above-referenced docket to solicit comments from TDS customers. The Commission's rules require, in some circumstances, that the Commission hold public statement hearings in the service territory of a utility, such as when it is proposing a major change in its service or rates. We believe that it is appropriate to hold hearings in locations within the companies' service territories for the public to provide comments on the TDS proposal for an alternative regulation plan. Such public statement hearings would provide the public with an opportunity to learn more about the company's proposed plan, as well as provide the Commission with the public's views on the proposal.
