On Thursday, November 13, 2008, Global NAPs filed a cover letter and supplemental representation to support its request for confidential treatment pursuant to RSA 378:43, II of its 2005, 2006 and 2007 annual reports in the above-captioned docket. Upon review of the filing, Staff recommends the Commission grant confidential treatment provided that parties to the docket have, indeed, received copies of the annual reports under protective agreement, as Global NAPs asserts in its cover letter.
