As required in NHPUC Order 23,980 dated May 30, 2002, and the Electric Assistance Procedures Manuals, attached are the following monthly reports for July 2013 on PSNH's Electric Assistance Program (EAP):

- 1. EAP System Benefits Charge (SBC) Reconciliation;
- 2. Number of active EAP participants and participation levels by discount tier and discount amounts per tier; and,
- 3. Aging comparison between EAP and other residential accounts.

Additionally, on August 2, 2013, the Program Administrator was provided customer billing, and payment information via File Transfer Protocol (FTP) as required by the Procedures Manuals.

For the month of July 2013, PSNH expenses were \$110,307.67 below the Net SBC Funding. The net cumulative amount remitted by the State Treasury for PSNH program expenditures since inception stands at \$7,675,133.48.

The cover letter for the June EAP report inadvertently stated that the net cumulative amount remitted by the State Treasury for PSNH program expenditures since inception stands at \$7,682,607.16 instead of \$7,785,441.15.
